Take things one day, one event and one meal at a time. Arm your strategies to stay healthy when the holiday season arrives. Go for holiday strategy. Space your carbohydrate consumption out throughout the day. Choose which carbohydrates to eat at a given time. For example, do not have a heaping mound of mashed potatoes with cornbread stuffing and a buttered roll. This will

send your blood sugar soaring in no time. Instead, have a small portion of the mashed potatoes, turkey breast, and vegetables. Omit the stuffing and roll or enjoy them later in the day. Another tip is to plan ahead for a party. Do not go to an event hungry. Eat a small, light meal beforehand to ensure that you do not go too long without eating. Eat every 3-4 hours, even at holiday times. Remember to balance meals and snacks with protein, complex carbohydrates, vegetables, and fruit. Bring a healthful entrée' to the event to guarantee that some healthful food is there. Also be smart at buffets. They spell portion disaster. Handle this one like a pro by not diving into the food without first looking at what

is offered. Take a smaller plate, and fill it up with fresh vegetables, lean protein and simple carbohydrates. Do not go back for seconds and split dessert with a few friends. Stick to MyPlate since it has lots of strategies for proper portion and proportions. Remember to fill half your plate with fruits and veggies at each meal and choose whole grains over refined ones. Consider your alcohol consumption. Festive atmospheres often include alcohol. Talk with your healthcare provider about how much alcohol you should consume. Insulin and some diabetes medications do not interact well with alcohol. And don't forget to keep up your exercise routine. Physical activity is key to

managing blood sugar levels, keeping excess weight off, and enabling you to stay on track around the holidays. Sixty minutes most days of the week whether walking, jogging, or dancing is all you need to do and it doesn't have to be continuous. Plan a time to get your workout in and stick to it, or set aside little 10-minute intervals for a few quick reps here or there throughout the day. I have a final reminder about an upcoming Healthy Holiday Cooking Demonstration presented by Kathy Durbin, Registered Dietician at McAlester Regional Health Center and myself scheduled for Monday, December 7th, at 7:00 p.m. at the MRHC Wellness Center, Strong and Van Buren. 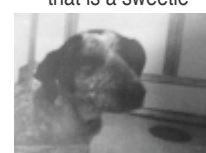

## When to Call 911

In an emergency, call 911 or your local emergency number immediately from any wired or wireless phone. An emergency is any situation that requires immediate assistance from the police, fire department or ambulance. Examples include:

- A fire
- A crime, especially if in progress
- A car crash, especially if someone is injured
- A medical emergency, such as someone who is unconscious, gasping for air or not breathing, experiencing an allergic reaction, having chest pain, having uncontrollable bleeding, or any other

symptoms that require immediate medical attention When you call 911, be prepared to answer the dispatcher's questions, which may include:

- The location of the emergency, including the street address
  - The phone number you are calling from
  - The nature of the emergency
  - Details about the emergency, such as a physical description of a person who may have committed a crime, a description of any fire that may be burning, or a description of injuries or symptoms being experienced by a person having a medical emergency
- Remember, the dispatcher's questions are important to get the right kind of help to you quickly. Dispatcher's

may ask you specific questions about suspect/suspects or weapons involved. This helps officers responding to be more prepared and help keep them safer when arriving at a scene.

Be prepared to follow any instructions the dispatcher gives you. Our 911 center can tell you exactly what to do to help in an emergency until help arrives, such as providing step-by-step instructions to aid someone who is choking or needs first aid or CPR.

Finally, do not hang up until the dispatcher instructs you to. If you dial 911 by mistake, or if a child in your home dials 911 when no emergency exists, do not hang up—that could make 911 dispatcher think that an emergency exists, and possibly send


responders to your location. Instead, simply explain to the dispatcher what happened. Information contained in this article was taken from 911.gov.

## On National Rural Health Day, Secretary Vilsack Touts Benefits of Affordable Care Act to Rural Communities, Announces New Health Investments

Affordable Care Act provides incentives to encourage doctors to serve in rural America, funds rural health centers, helps rural Americans get access to care USDA awarding more than \$10 million in grants to support telemedicine and rural health research Washington, D.C., Nov. 20, 2014 - Today, on National Rural Health Day, Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack announced more than \$10 million in grants through two U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) programs to improve access to health care for rural

Americans across the nation. The Secretary also highlighted initiatives created by the Affordable Care Act that specifically address critical health needs in rural communities. "Delivering these programs to rural communities that often do not have access to quality, affordable medical and educational services has tremendous economic and social benefits," Vilsack said. "They also mean that people who live and work in rural areas will not have to travel long distances for specialized health care services. These investments mean that

students in rural high schools will have educational opportunities often not available outside urban areas." Through the Distance Learning and Telemedicine (DLT) program, USDA has helped hundreds of rural communities deliver care in remote areas since it began two decades ago. Today, USDA's Rural Development is awarding \$20.4 million in grants that will provide rural Americans access to medical services, improve educational opportunities, and support Native American communities. Fiscal Year 2014 Distance Learning and Telemedicine Grant recipients

Rural residents are more likely to report a fair to poor health status and have higher rates of health complications, morbidity and mortality due to challenges associated with low levels of employment and education, geographic barriers and isolation, lack of quality nutrition and health education, and lack of access to health care. USDA's National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA) is awarding 12 grants totaling more than \$1.4 million to universities aimed at enhancing the quality of life in rural areas through improved health and safety education efforts. NIFA funded the grants through the Rural Health and Safety Education program which addresses these challenges by

developing programs that provide the necessary health information to rural residents. The program has three main focus areas: 1) individual and family nutrition and health education; 2) farm safety education; and 3) rural health leadership development education. Projects funded in fiscal year 2014 focus on a diversity of rural health and safety issues, from diabetes education, obesity prevention, and physical activity and healthy nutrition education, to eco-healthy child care promotion,

and rural expansion of 4-H Healthy Living program. Fiscal Year 2014 Rural Health and Safety Education Grant recipients In addition to today's announcements, Secretary Vilsack encouraged rural Americans to take advantage of the Health Insurance Marketplace created by the Affordable Care Act and discussed the health care reform law's specific benefits for rural communities. "Rural residents have higher rates of chronic conditions. This can be exacerbated by a lack of doctors or clinics in rural communities," Secretary Vilsack continued. "The Affordable Care Act is improving the health of rural communities and giving all families the security they deserve. No one should go

without healthcare because of where they live, or be forced to leave the communities they love to get the coverage they need." Rural Americans suffer from higher rates of chronic conditions like diabetes, heart disease and high blood pressure. The Affordable Care Act has taken steps to address the unique challenges rural communities face when it comes to getting the health care they need. One in five uninsured Americans lives in a rural area, and yet on average only 10 percent of the nation's physicians practice in these communities. The Affordable Care Act has significantly

increased the size of the National Health Service Corps, which offers scholarships and loan repayment to health practitioners in return for practicing in rural communities and other underserved areas. More than 3,500 Corps members now serve in rural areas, and an average of 86 percent of them will remain in their communities even after completing their service. The Affordable Care Act also invests significantly in expanding services at community health centers, where 7.5 million rural

Americans get access to primary and preventive care. That comes on top of the more than \$3 billion USDA has invested since 2009 to strengthen health infrastructure in rural areas, building rural hospitals and health clinics and expanding access to health care in remote rural areas through telemedicine. Not only can a lack of health insurance coverage help lead to high rates of chronic conditions, it threatens rural families economic health as well. Before the Affordable Care Act passed, the average rural family paid nearly 50%

of all health costs out of pocket. One in five farmers is in debt because of medical bills. Uninsured individuals living in rural areas are able to use the Marketplaces to compare qualified health plan insurance options based on price, benefits, quality, and other factors with a clear picture of premiums and cost-sharing amounts to help them choose the qualified health insurance plan that best fits their needs. Open Enrollment for the Health Insurance Marketplace began Nov. 15, 2014, and runs through Feb. 15, 2015. Those who have plans can continue them without re-enrolling. However, consumers are encouraged to visit [HealthCare.gov](http://HealthCare.gov) to review and compare health plan options and find out if they are eligible for financial assistance, which can help pay monthly premiums and reduce out-of-pocket costs when receiving services. In order to have coverage effective on Jan. 1, 2015, consumers must enroll or update their coverage by

December 15. ### Kitchen myths busted

There are many actions we take in the kitchen in the name of food safety. But are these ideas fact or fiction? It

is time to debunk some popular kitchen myths. First, many consumers purchase bagged greens labeled "ready to eat," "washed" or "triple washed." But intuition tells us an extra rinse will not hurt anything. Rinsing ready-to-eat food can actually increase the potential for cross-contamination. Pathogens that may be on your kitchen surfaces or your hands could find their way onto your greens in the process of handling them. Save yourself a little bit of time and just enjoy your salad with peace of mind. Some people believe cross-


contamination cannot happen in the refrigerator due to the cold temperature. However, some bacteria can survive and grow in cool, moist places. *Listeria monocytogenes* grows in temperatures as low as 35.6 degrees Fahrenheit. Be sure to keep fresh fruits and vegetables separate from raw meat, poultry, seafood and eggs. Clean your refrigerator regularly with hot water and soap, and clean up food and beverage spills immediately to help reduce the risk of cross-contamination in your refrigerator. Remember to clean refrigerator walls, as well as the undersides of the shelves. Another popular belief is it is only important to wash fresh fruits and vegetables - there is no need to dry them,

too. This is false. Research has shown drying fruits and vegetables with a paper towel or clean dish cloth further reduces the level of harmful bacteria on the surface of fresh produce. Another popular myth some people believe is there's no need to rinse various types of melons because they don't eat the skin. What they don't understand is there are many ways for pathogens on the outside of a melon to contaminate the edible part. The knife or peeler passing through the rind can carry pathogens to the flesh of the melon. In addition, the rind also touches the edible part when cut fruit is arranged or stacked for serving or garnish if it hasn't been peeled. Play it safe and rinse the melon under running tap water and scrub

lightly with a vegetable brush or your hands. Dry it with a clean cloth or paper towel. These myths certainly sound as if they're true, but by debunking them you're putting your family one step ahead with food safety in the kitchen. AP File Photo Gary Kazanjian - AP Economists expect that lower prices will give consumers a little extra money to spend on other items, which will be a welcome surprise, especially since costs of this year's Thanksgiving meal are expected to rise slightly. Eventually, lower gasoline prices could stimulate more driving demand or encourage refineries to reduce production. This could ultimately cause prices to rise, but drivers can enjoy cheap fuel for now. Bountiful grain harvest U.S. corn and soybean farmers are also giving thanks this week as their record-breaking harvest nears completion. After wet conditions slowed progress across much of the Grain Belt during the last few months, most farmers are finally wrapping up harvest with more than 90

percent of corn and 95 percent of soybeans brought out of the fields. Despite the tough harvest conditions, 2014 has turned out to be the biggest production year for corn and soybeans in history. Total corn production is estimated at 14.4 billion bushels with a national average yield of 173.4 bushels per acre, and soybean production is nearing 4 billion bushels with a national average yield of 47.5 bushels per acre. Due to the massive crops, prices for grains are significantly lower this fall than the past few years, but recent demand from end users has helped to stabilize prices, which stood Friday at \$3.80 per bushel for corn and \$10.40 for soybeans. Cold shocks OJ market Extreme cold temperatures in Florida this week sparked fears that frost could hit orange groves later this winter. Although unusual

for the Sunshine State, hard freezes can derail production, cutting sharply into supplies. As a result, prices for frozen concentrated orange juice futures catapulted 20 cents higher from one-year lows, reaching \$1.42 on Friday. If the crop avoids significant damage this winter, many analysts expect prices to go lower as Americans have been shying away from

orange juice in recent years, favoring more exotic juices or lower-sugar beverages. Opinions are solely the writers'. "I congratulate this fine group of Senators on their election to Senate leadership," Bingman said. "These men and women will be instrumental in our efforts to advance conservative policy."

The 55th Legislature will include eight new Republican Senators. Four Senate seats have switched from Democrat to Republican, including Marty Quinn (District 2), Joseph Silk (District 5), Roger Thompson (District 8), and Darcy Jech (District

26). The Senate will also welcome four freshmen in seats previously held by Republicans with the addition of Senators Stephanie Bice (District 22), Jason Smalley (District 28), Ervin Yen (District 40), and

Jack Fry (District 42). The Senate will meet for organizational day on Jan. 6, where leaders will be formally elected and rules for the 2015 session will be passed.

## Sen. Brian Crain announces bond packages for eternal education trusts

OKLAHOMA CITY -- Sen. Brian Crain is promoting legislation for the 2015 session to secure critically needed additional education funding in Oklahoma by creating separate trusts for higher and common education through two 30-year, \$2.5 billion bond issues.

The innovative solution to Oklahoma's efforts to secure permanent additional education funding would raise money over 30 years to create the trusts, which would provide money for education in addition to standard appropriations.

"While the investment will take about 30 years to pay off, the trusts that are created will be eternal," said Crain, R-Tulsa. "They will last as long as the state of Oklahoma."

The \$2.5 billion trust for higher education would be invested to secure Oklahoma's continued relevance in the career fields in the highest current and expected future demand: science, technology, engineering, mathematics and medicine. The trust would help recruit and retain faculty, provide tuition assistance to students in those disciplines who agree to remain in Oklahoma for at least five years after graduation, and help research foundations that work with universities in those areas.

Forty percent of the funding would go to the University of Oklahoma, 40 percent would go to Oklahoma State University, and the additional 20 percent would be earmarked for regional colleges and universities.

The \$2.5 billion trust for common education would be used to increase teacher salaries in similar disciplines to those supported by the higher education trust: science, technology, engineering and mathematics.

The common education trust would be controlled by a board of stakeholders like educators, administrators, parents and business leaders. The board members will be appointed by the School Land Commission, the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

The higher education trust would be controlled by a board chaired by the State Treasurer or a designee and appointees from the Governor, State Auditor and Inspector, Senate President Pro Tempore and Speaker of the House of Representatives.

The bond issue legislation will include a clause that requires the Legislature to maintain existing education funding and not consider the trust money to replace standard appropriations. The bond issues would need approval from the full Legislature, and would then be put to a statewide vote.

"This gives the people of Oklahoma the opportunity to say, 'This is where we want our money spent,'" Crain said.

## Senate President Pro Tem responds to reinstatement of No Child Left Behind waiver

Senate President Pro Tempore Brian Bingman said Monday that the reinstatement of Oklahoma's No Child Left Behind waiver ensures the state's education reform efforts will continue.

"With the federal government's politics now out of the way, Oklahoma can take the next step and develop high standards that prepare our students to compete in the new global economy. Today's schools house the next generation of Oklahoma's workforce. As a result, the academic standards we develop will directly impact our job market and economy for years to come. ### Spraying for Insects in Winter

As we move closer to winter here in Pittsburg County, now is a great time to look at insect control. Many insects such as mites, gall forming insects, aphids, etc., have an overwintering stage or hide out on plants during winter months in cracks and crevices of trunks and stems. One way to control them and keep their numbers to a low roar this growing season is to spray them with horticultural oil during the winter months. Horticulture oils are petroleum-based products containing certain fatty acids that form layers on plant parts to smother insects and provide a mechanical barrier to prevent damage. There are two kinds of oils: growing season (summer) and dormant. Some common examples include:

- Sunspray (6E Plus): Normal dormant use. Summer use on vegetables, greenhouse ornamentals, flower and foliage plants, some fruit and nut trees, some field

crops, blueberries, grapes and citrus.

- Ortho Volck Oil Spray: Dormant and summer use on citrus, fruit and shade trees, evergreens, and some shrubs.

- Scalecide: Dormant and summer use on fruit and shade trees, ornamentals, evergreen and small fruit. Indoor or outdoor use.

"Dormant" refers to the time of year the application is made. Remember, as a general rule, that oils control insects, not plant diseases. Dormant oil should not be applied when the temperature is below 40° F and if there is a danger of freezing. Some dormant oil sprays should not be applied to evergreens or to certain deciduous tree species. Be sure to read and follow the product label. For more information on insect control, contact your local OSU Extension office.

# Group Of 35 Legislators Potential Court Ruling Could Overturn a Decade of Tax Relief for Oklahomans

OKLAHOMA CITY— A group of 35 state legislators released an open letter Thursday voicing concerns about the possibility that many tax relief measures passed

in Oklahoma over the past decade could be overturned, should the state Supreme Court rule that tax reductions must meet the guidelines of State Question 640.

Passed on a statewide ballot by voters in 1992 as an amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution, SQ 640 was intended to make it more difficult for the state Legislature to

increase taxes. According to the provision, all proposals increasing state taxes must either be sent to a vote of the people or receive three-fourths approval in both houses of the Legislature. Such measures also cannot be approved in the final five days of the legislative session.

At question is the fate of Senate Bill 1246, an income tax reduction measure passed by the Legislature during the 2014 session. The new statute's constitutionality has been challenged in a lawsuit, filed with the state Supreme Court, on the grounds that it did not meet the standards of SQ 640. The Court heard arguments on the suit last month.

The 35 lawmakers who endorsed the letter hail from all four quadrants of the state. The two legislators who carried SB 1246 in the Senate and House of Representatives, respectively – state Sen. Kyle Loveless, R-Oklahoma City, and state Rep. Leslie Osborn, R-Mustang – endorsed the letter.

In the letter, the lawmakers make the case that it was not the aim of Oklahoma voters in 1992 to make it more difficult for the Legislature to reduce taxes. Rather, the intent was to make it harder to increase taxes.

If the Court were to rule against SB 1246 on the grounds that tax relief measures must meet the standards of SQ 640, numerous previous tax reductions could be overturned, including: income tax reductions, estate tax repeal, increases in the standard deduction, gross production tax rate reductions, manufacturing exemptions, and tax relief for retirees, military veterans and disabled veterans.

# Mercy Clinic merges with MRHC

As the founder of a free medical clinic in McAlester steps down, McAlester Regional Health Center is stepping forward to ensure the area's most vulnerable residents will still have access to basic health care. Dr. Larry Lewis founded the Mercy Health Clinic of McAlester 22 years ago, offering free services with the help of volunteers, donations and organizations such as MRHC. The clinic had been offered weekly on Wednesday nights out of the Pittsburg County Health Department for those without health insurance or the ability to pay for health care. Dr. Lewis this month announced to Mercy Clinic patients his intention to begin phasing out some of his medical practices and the planned transition of Mercy Clinic to MRHC. "The Mercy Clinic has a huge legacy in this community," said MRHC CEO David Keith. "It has always been about making health care accessible to the most vulnerable."

A transition team from the hospital and Mercy Clinic is working to make the move as easy as possible for Mercy Clinic clients. For instance, there will be no name change, and few changes in how clients will schedule appointments or obtain services. What will change, beginning with the first clinic in 2015 on Jan. 9, will be the location and time of service. The new Mercy Health Clinic of McAlester will be offered on Fridays from 1-5 p.m. (instead of Wednesday nights). The new clinic location will be in the Physician's Building of MRHC (the copper-roofed building on the MRHC Campus), just a block away on Strong Boulevard from the previous location at the Pittsburg County Health Department. The new Mercy Health Clinic location will be within the MRHC Southeast Family Practice Associates on the third floor of the Physician's Building. The phone number to call for appointments is also the same: 918-426-4306. Scheduling of appointments for Friday's Mercy Clinics will begin at 8:30 a.m. that day. Once the schedule is filled, callers will reach an automated recording. MRHC Southeast Family Practice Associates is home to the MRHC Physician Residency Program with Oklahoma State University. For the past two weeks, OSU doctors serving their residency with MRHC have also been pitching in at Mercy Health Clinic each Wednesday, along with Dr. Lewis and other volunteer doctors and nurses. It is expected that Mercy Health Clinic clients will continue to benefit from the expertise of the OSU-trained resident doctors, as well as a wider pool of medical specialists and other resources. Dr. Carol Gambrell supervises the MRHC Residency Program and will be one of the new physicians providing care to Mercy Health Clinic patients. Doctors, nurses or other volunteers who wish to help may contact MRHC Foundation Director Stephanie Giacomo at 918-421-8687. Another benefit to Mercy Health Clinic patients will be help finding health coverage through Medicaid or the Health Insurance Marketplace. "Our goal is to get you access to health care," said Keith, the CEO for the hospital. He said he's excited MRHC has the opportunity to continue Dr. Lewis' work and the legacy of the Mercy Health Clinic. "Lewis and the Mercy Clinic were ahead of their time," Keith said. "And now we have an opportunity to carry on that legacy and help the people in our community who need it most."

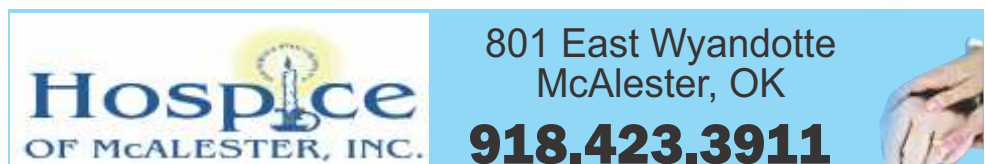
