





Domestic Violence



The McAlester Police Department responds to Domestic Violence calls on a daily basis. Many times when our officers arrive, we get very little cooperation. This is generally due to one party being scared or not wanting to get the other in trouble. These types of relationships can then escalate and have a very bad ending, leaving one party in jail and the other in the hospital.

Domestic violence is domestic abuse that includes physical violence. It is not limited to just one form of abuse. Domestic violence may also include sexual abuse, emotional abuse, psychological abuse, financial abuse, and stalking. It is vital that you have as much information as possible and are aware of the seriousness of domestic violence. Abusers are fully aware and in control of what they are saying and doing. When an abuser is in a rage and friends come by, suddenly everything is fine. Abusers don't beat on their girlfriend just because the abuser is drunk, tired, hungry, or stressed.

Why is your abuser beating on you? Abusers are abusive to gain and maintain total control over you and the situation. Some of the abuse is

spontaneous, and some of it is premeditated. Getting out alive will require some premeditated planning, but also spontaneous thinking and action on your part. Abusers will tell you what their intentions are, in the form of a threat. It is your responsibility to believe your abuser. Your life and the lives of your children depend on it. Knowing the domestic violence cycle will help you understand what is going on in your relationship with your abuser. As you look at this cycle, I hope you can look at it from your abuser's point of view and remember

that your abuser's only purpose in abusing you is to gain and maintain total control over you! This is NOT vour fault! The domestic violence cycle has three phases; Tension building: As hard as you try,

nothing you do is right or good enough. Please be careful and try to defuse any situations. This is the time when your abuser wants to gain, or maintain control and is setting things up for the next phase of this cycle. Battering: Every victim's scariest moment. Again try hard to defuse the situation, and be careful!! Leaving is the most dangerous moment in a domestic violence situation, if you think you will live through this moment, plan to leave during the next phase. Otherwise, call the police now!!

Honeymoon: Your abuser may apologize, or blame you for what just took place in the previous phase. The abuser will act like things are normal, or be extra nice to insure that you won't report the abuse. The abuser may start making plans for something you have wanted, plans for the family,

plans for the future ... whatever the abuser thinks will keep you in this relationship. Please know that the Honeymoon Phase is the safest phase to secretly start getting your ducks in a row and make a plan so you can safely leave.


These three phases are in a continual cycle. You may be telling yourself that your loved one didn't mean to hurt you and didn't mean the words that were said. Would you treat, or talk to a loved one that way? Would you treat, or talk to anyone that way? If your answer is, "no!" then do not excuse the words and actions that were directed at you. This is a control issue. In my experience and what I have heard from others as this cycle continues, it progressively gets worse to maintain control. This cycle does not get better. You need to take care of yourself and your children. Start making a safety plan now to get out of this situation. Some information contained in this article was taken from policeone.com On domestic calls in McAlester the Officer will ask the victim several questions on a form that is called a lethality assessment. If there are yes answers to the threat of further violence then an advocate is called on the phone at the scene and the victim has a chance to get immediate assistance. The form is then attached to the Police report.

In 2012-2013, the Montana Cooperative Development Center helped the Big Flat Market Cooperative steering committee with its incorporation process and business planning. The result of this hard work is the Big Flat Grocery store, now open in rural Turner, Mont., near the Canadian border.

The release of the co-op Top 100 report comes as USDA celebrates National Cooperative Month

theme is "Cooperatives Build." Secretary Vilsack kicked off the month-long celebration with an official proclamation.
